### Guidelines for Preparation of Abstract for Oral/Poster Presentations

1. The abstract must be written in good English and provide an informative summary of the research work.
2. **Font types:** Times New Roman
3. **Font size:**  
**Title:** 12 font, bold  
**Affiliations:** 12 font  
**Main body of text:** 12 font  
**List of authors:** 12 font  
**Presenting author's email:** 12 font  
**Key Words:** 12 font (Not more than six)
4. The overall word count of the abstract should not exceed 250 words.
5. **Abstract body:** The abstract shall comprise an introduction, aim & objectives, methods, results, summary, conclusion, and keywords as per the given template.
6. Abbreviations or acronyms, except units of measurement and those that are widely used or known, should be defined at first mention.
7. **Originality, plagiarism, ethical approval, copyright:** It is the responsibility of the authors to ensure originality of the research, as well as the abstract and posters.
8. It is also the responsibility of the authors to ensure appropriate ethical/regulatory approval is taken wherever applicable for the images/data/research material which is presented in this conference.
9. Any clarifications regarding abstract submission should be sent to [ics22scientific@isfcp.org](mailto:ics22scientific@isfcp.org) with the subject of the mail.

## Poster Presentation Guidelines

Participants presenting posters at the **22<sup>nd</sup> International Cyclodextrin Symposium (ICS-22)** should adhere to the following guidelines:

### General Information

1. Each selected poster will be assigned a unique number. The organizing committee will notify participants of the scheduled date, time, and venue for their poster presentation.
2. Font- Times New Roman
3. Font Size- Title- 60 points Bold and CAPITALS,
  - 45 Points for Author's name
  - 35 Points for Affiliations
  - 30 points bold for headings & subheadings
  - 20-26 points normal font type for running text
4. The preferred background shall be white, font color must be black only and no color font shall be used
5. **Poster Size** 3 feet width × 4 Feet Height (90 cm width × 120 cm height).  
Posters larger than this cannot be accommodated
6. Presenters must prepare and print their posters using the official ICS-22 template. The template can be downloaded from the provided link.

### Poster Content Requirements

- Abstract Track ID: Ensure that your poster prominently displays the unique abstract track ID provided during submission.
- Author Details: Include the names and affiliations of all authors, with the presenting author's name underlined.
- Structured Format: Organize the content into the following sections:  
Introduction
  - Aim & Objectives
  - Methods
  - Results
  - Discussion/Conclusion
  - Acknowledgement

- Readability: Posters should be legible from a distance of 2-3 meters.
- High-Resolution Images: Use images of sufficient resolution for clarity and visual impact.

#### **Poster Setup and Display**

- Posters must be placed on the designated poster board 15 minutes before the assigned time slot.
- Acceptable materials for the poster include paper, canvas, or flex.
- Graphs and figures should also be clearly visible from a distance of 2-3 meters.

#### **Poster Session Guidelines**

1. The organizing committee will communicate the specific date and time of the poster session.
2. All authors are required to be present at their poster during the assigned session.
3. Presenters must wear the official conference badge while presenting.

## Moga to Chandigarh 150 km (2.5 hr)

### Local Sightseeing Options Around Chandigarh

Chandigarh, known as The City Beautiful, is a well-planned city with a perfect blend of modern architecture and natural beauty. It also serves as a gateway to several stunning attractions nearby.

#### 1. Sukhna Lake

- Description: A serene man-made lake at the foothills of the Shivalik Hills, perfect for boating, jogging, or just relaxing by the water.
- Key Highlights: Boating, walking trails, sunrise/sunset views, and migratory bird watching (seasonal).
- Distance: Located within Chandigarh city.



#### 2. Rock Garden

- Distance: Located in Sector 16, Chandigarh.



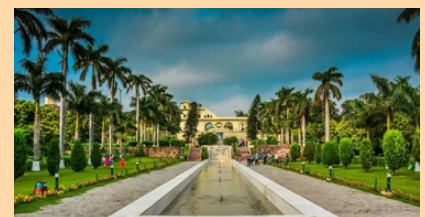
#### 4. Capitol Complex

#### 5. Pinjore Gardens
